

RESOLUTION NO. 2015-08

INTRODUCED BY:

A Resolution accepting the bid of Perrin Asphalt Co., Inc. for the Cranbrook Drive Reconstruction Project and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the Finance Director was authorized to advertise for bids for the construction of the Cranbrook Drive Reconstruction Project; and

WHEREAS, the Finance Director published the advertisement pursuant to Section 731.14 of the Ohio Revised Code; and

WHEREAS, Council intends to accept the bid of Perrin Asphalt Co., Inc., for the Cranbrook Drive Reconstruction Project for a sum not to exceed \$846,949.00; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Northfield will fund its share of the Cranbrook Drive Reconstruction Project from the Village Sewer Fund; Village General Fund; and Street Construction, Maintenance and Repair Fund for a total amount not exceeding \$846,949.00; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Northfield, County of Summit, and State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. Council hereby accepts the bid of Perrin Asphalt Co., Inc. for the Cranbrook Drive Reconstruction Project for a sum not to exceed \$846,949.00. The bid of Perrin Asphalt Co., Inc. is hereby designated the lowest and best bid, and the contract is hereby awarded.

SECTION 2. The sum of \$846,949.00 is hereby appropriated for the purpose of constructing the Cranbrook Drive Reconstruction Project set forth above, and the Finance Director, the Mayor, the Engineer, Law Director are hereby authorized to proceed with the project.

SECTION 3. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and welfare of the residents of the Village of Northfield in that the prompt construction of the Cranbrook Drive Reconstruction Project is in the best interest of the residents of the Village of Northfield, and that this Resolution shall take immediate effect upon its signature by the Mayor, or upon the expiration of time within which it may be disapproved by the Mayor, or upon its passage after its disapproval by the Mayor, as the case may be, pursuant to the Village of Northfield Charter Section 4.11.
