**Road Updates:**

**Presidential Sub-Division -**

After countless hours of debate over the last couple of years, we have come up with the best solution possible for the well over-due Presidential sub-division road surface.

The original plan called for full reconstruction of the roads. Reconstructing one road per year, starting with a road behind the plaza, then next, a road in the Presidential streets. This plan is just not realistic, being that the condition of the roads in the Presidential sub-division are extremely poor. Full reconstruction of each of these roads will take several years and financially the Village can not reconstruct all of the roads at once.

The next best option for replacement, is the recycle process. Basically 6” of the current road surface will be recycled in this process and it is done with a machine that grinds 6” of the road, it is heated and rejuvenated, then repaved and rolled giving a very good base. Once this is complete, the paving crew will come in and put 2” of new asphalt over the top. This process is very reliable. The Presidential sub-division was done this way in 1993, which was the last time the roads were paved. We feel this will give the Village the time to get prepared for full reconstruction and this method of the replacement will easily give us 10-12 years.

Concrete curb and gutter will be replace as needed. The areas that are poor will be replaced and new pavement from curb to curb will be done. Please understand this is an excellent option of replacement. The bottom line is that nine roads need to be replaced now.

Mayor Nehez and Council President/Ward D Councilman Nick Magistrelli, have spent countless hours planning and worrying about this project wanting to address all of the residents in the Presidential subdivision. Village Engineer Rich Wasosky has designed this as the best solution to address all of the concerns. They feel that they truly have put so much into making sure this project is not only complete, but done in the best way possible.

#### Kennedy Blvd.

The Village will be installing a new storm system on Kennedy Blvd from Vorderman west to the turn. This area is extremely in need of a storm system. This will be completed with the Presidential subdivision pavement project.

#### Maple Ave.

This August 2017, Maple Ave. will be repaved with a 3” in mill & fill process. 3” of the current pavement will be removed with a grinding process and 3” of new asphalt to replace.
