

*News from the service department about Mailbox  
Damage during the Snow Season:*

Mailbox damage is inevitable when streets are being plowed. Typically, damage is not caused by direct contact with the plow, but rather the snow that is thrown off the road. The snow is very wet and heavy and can strike the box with considerable force. It is important that your mailbox be in good condition, securely attached to a substantial support at the proper height, and at the proper distance from the roadway. Custom-made mailboxes should be shielded or replaced for the winter with a standard box. The Service Department will make repairs or replace only mailboxes that have been damaged by snowplows. You should inspect your mailbox and post to see if it is sturdy enough to withstand the snow hitting it that is being removed from the roadway.

There are numerous mailboxes and posts around the village that are ready to fall over at any moment. Please inspect your mailbox and make any changes before the snow season begins.
