Service Dept:

Village road crack filling program:

Started September 5th and ended September 20th. We crack filled 21 streets: Beech, Birch, Cambridge, Chestnut, Cranbrook, Coventry, Electric, Elm, Fell, Filly, Heights, Meadow Ln., Magnolia, May, Milford (half), Rosewood, Stratford, Summit, Sunset, Victory and Vincent

We also sealed several road repairs.

Senior Resident Driveway Snow Plowing Program:

Signups have started and will continue until October 31. It is that time of year, again, and ALL SENIOR Northfield Village residents who want to utilize the Village's Senior Snow Plowing Service are urged to sign up early for the 2017-2018 season at the Service Department Offices at 199 Ledge Road. We are happy to report that the senior snow plowing service program will be in effect again this year.

IT IS NECESSARY FOR ALL RESIDENTS WHO QUALIFY FOR THIS SERVICE TO FILL OUT A NEW APPLICATION FOR THE 2017-2018 SEASON REGARDLESS OF WHETHER YOU HAVE RECEIVED THIS SERVICE IN THE PAST OR NOT. Deadline is October 31st, to submit application.

Applicants must be at least 65 years of age. **Proof of age must be shown.**

Applications can be filled out at the Service Department Offices at 199 Ledge Road or can be downloaded from the Village website at www.northfieldvillage-oh.gov on the Service/Building Dept. page and brought to 199 Ledge Road. Applications must be submitted in person. Your ID must be submitted (a photocopy will be made) with the application along with the non-refundable \$5.00 fee. Payment can be made by check or cash. If payment is made by cash, exact change is necessary

Village Leaf Pickup Program:

The Service Department will pick-up leaves as follows:

Time frame for leaf pickup is October 30th - November 22nd.

Pickup will start on the east side of the Village with Ward C then Ward B. Once this side is complete they will then move to the west side of the Village to pickup Ward A and then Ward D.

Once we have completed a street, we will not return. If a resident still has leaves, he or she should bag them for rubbish pick-up. Bags should not weigh more than 40lbs. Every home should have their leaves out by the 1st day of the dates listed above for that ward.

Please check the Village message board in front of the Village hall periodically for information, contact the Service Department at 330 468 4363 or stop at the service department at 199 Ledge Rd to pick up the leaf schedule.

Sewer Dept:

Village sewer cleaning of the main sewer lines will began in August. Please leave toilet lids closed when not in use beware sounds and splash back in toilets and drains might be experienced this is normal

Building & Zoning Dept:

Rocksino Gas Station & Car Wash: Is almost finished and the grand opening is scheduled for October 18th.

Village offensive grass/weed ordinance: Has been from eight inches to six inches.

660.17 No owner or occupancy in possession or control of any parcel of land in the Municipality with a single family residential zoning classification, whether the parcel is improved or unimproved or occupied or vacant, shall fail to keep the entirety of such parcel, or any public right of way or tree lawn abutting such parcel, free from offensive grass and offensive weeds exceeding six inches in height as defined.
